Notes

1 The first year charge is refundable on completion of your course of study subject to deduction of £20 for fee insurance, and the cost of rectifying any damage to your room or other College property. The amount of the charge is under review by Council, and may in future be doubled, so that the amount shown above is charged in the second year as well as the first year.

Please note that the deposits shown above are payable by all students, and are in addition to any deposit required from self-funding students as a financial guarantee. Self-funding students will be required to pay a deposit equivalent to one term's bill, including University fees and all College fees and charges. This deposit will be refunded against your last bill before completion of your course

2 In Girton Road houses and College hostels, the heating prepayment is set off against the actual charge. In College, background heating is included in the charge for rent. Additional electricity usage is metered and charged at cost including VAT @ 5%.

3 The Kitchen Fixed Charge is a contribution to catering overheads payable by all student members of College. Meals taken in College or Wolfson Court are moderately priced and paid for individually at the time of eating

4 Not all rooms have this facility; a charge will only be made where the facility is available and is used

5 SICK BAY - there is normally no charge for sick bay, but the College reserves the right to charge in exceptional circumstances

6 Fines and interest will be charged on overdue accounts as approved from time to time by Council

7 College reserves the right to charge an additional deposit where there is a telephone in the house unless outgoing calls are barred

8 Council Tax will be paid by the College and re-charged where applicable

9 Student members are entitled to three free Formal Hall tickets *per annum*, one or two of which may be used for guests.
