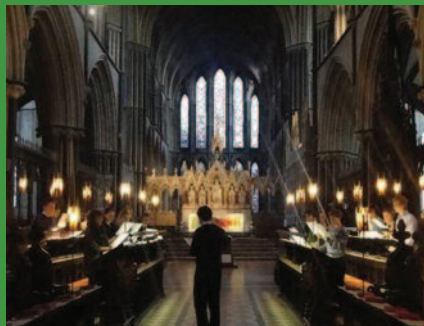

Girton has an ambitious international touring schedule, with recent ventures to the U.S.A. (pictured above), Slovakia, Austria, Germany, Switzerland, Singapore (pictured below), Malaysia, Australia, Japan, Hong Kong, the Czech Republic, Italy, Germany and France. The choir has sung for the United Nations, for the Duke of Edinburgh, the

late Queen Mother and for the late Pope John Paul II.

The choir performs regularly in the major cathedrals: Norwich, Salisbury, (pictured below), Exeter, Lincoln, Worcester (pictured above), York Minster and Westminster Abbey. The repertoire is extremely varied, ranging from Byrd to Britten and beyond.
