

GIRTON COLLEGE SWIMMING POOL RULES

Please note that there is no Lifeguard on duty at any time.

- Showering – It is requested that all pool users shower prior to entering the pool. This minimises contamination of the water and will also make the pool water feel warmer.
- Lone Swimming – Lone swimming is not permitted at any time by any pool user, whether Fellow, student or staff. This is monitored via CCTV.
- Non Swimmers – Poor or non-swimmers are not permitted to use the pool at any time even if supervised. All users must be competent swimmers.
- Diving – This is not permitted anywhere in the pool.
- Consideration of others - All pool users are expected to be careful and considerate to other pool users and staff, and must follow instructions from staff if asked to leave the pool. Unacceptable behaviour or contravention of the pool rules may result in the individual being reported to the Senior Tutor or Line Manager as appropriate for further action. Running or splashing is not permitted.
- Food and Drink – these are not permitted anywhere in the pool facility. Do not swim whilst under the influence of any intoxicating substance or after eating.
- Pool side equipment - The life saving apparatus and other pool side equipment should not be used for any other purpose than that which it is intended for.
- Photography – The taking of any pictures in the pool hall or through the windows to the pool hall is not permitted.
- CCTV – CCTV monitoring is in progress at all times at the Lodge.
- Opening Times – The pool is generally available from 7am until 8pm daily or as dictated otherwise by the Porters Lodge. Women only sessions are on Wednesdays and Saturdays between 10.30 and noon during term time only. The pool will be closed from time to time for maintenance.
- Group Swimming – no more than 15 swimmers are permitted in the pool at any one time.
- Users aged 18 or under – pool users this age must be supervised by at least one adult swimmer in the water.
- Electrical appliances – Under no circumstances are any electrical devices to be taken into the pool hall.
