

Girton College: What you can do from 17 May 2021 to 20 June 2021

17 May 2021 is Stage 3 of the Government's Roadmap out of lockdown, with students allowed to return to University, in person teaching permitted, limited household mixing allowed indoors, reopening of indoor hospitality, and fewer restrictions on outdoor gatherings.

BUT although national and local infection rates are now low, transmission risk remains, so you should avoid close contact with anyone you don't live with, unless you are quite sure that there is no risk of infection and transmission. You must also continue to wear a face covering indoors on College premises, except within your own household or when eating/drinking.

AND The majority of students are sitting exams online in their households throughout May and June. Some are taking lengthy takeaway papers. Restrictions on large group socialising on College Premises, especially within households, will therefore remain in place as usual during exam term.

Remember to test weekly to check and to protect others!

Visitors in College Households

Normal College rules on private social gatherings in exam term will apply, so no **private** social gatherings of more than 10 people anywhere on Girton College Premises, and no household parties without the Senior Tutor's prior permission. Permission is rarely extended in exam term indoors unless in exceptional circumstances, but may be possible for outdoor private gatherings, suitably distant from residential areas.

To limit disturbance to those sitting exams, until 25 June only 1 visitor at a time to each household. Visitors may stay overnight. Households must consult together to manage this. As agreed with the JCR/MCR you must notify your visitors via the sheet on the kitchen door, and keep their contact details for track and trace purposes. In addition, external visitors (anyone not resident in College) must as always be signed in and out at the lodge.

You may not enter or visit another College household without invitation and notification on the household register.

Visitors and Isolation Risk

As before, in the event of a positive Covid test for anyone in the household, the household must isolate for 10 days. All close contacts (including any overnight household visitors) would also have to isolate. Likewise, if a visitor tests positive within 2 days of a household visit, all their close contacts in the household would have to isolate. This is still the law, until at least 21 June.

Please therefore do everything you can to ensure that you avoid unnecessary close contact and isolations. Your visitor should be entertained in your own room, must wear a facemask when outside your room, must use a designated bathroom or where available, your ensuite and must not spend time in the kitchen.

Social Hub/Bar and Visitors

- Open for table service indoor and out from Monday 17 May.
- Max 6 per table indoors, up-to-10 per table outdoors in Ash Court.
- You may each bring 1 non-member guest to the Hub; guests must sign in at the Hub

Cafeteria

You may each bring 1 non-member guest to the cafeteria and sit in Hall; guests must sign in at the lodge and scan the QR code in the cafeteria for track and trace.

Formal Dinners

Members only, no guests to ensure sufficient capacity for Girton College members.

Public Rooms

Public rooms will continue to be used as additional study zones, except where needed for teaching, exam emergencies and organised College functions– availability is notified on the door. No visitors permitted in the study rooms, because of limited capacity.

Sports Facilities

Erg Room	Boat Club List Only Solo or up to 4 people from 2 households Open 7am-9pm 50-minute slots + 10 mins clean down – can book 2 consecutive slots for a longer session Book by phoning the lodge 01223 338999 no more than 48 hours in advance. Sign -n at Lodge for access
Squash Court	Open 9am-9pm Solo or 2 people Book by phoning the lodge 01223 338999 Bookings max 48 hrs in advance Slots are 50 minutes + 10 minutes clean down time and you can book consecutive slots for longer play. Book by phoning the lodge 01223 338999 no more than 48 hours in advance. Sign in at Lodge for access
Volleyball	Please follow covid guidelines, risk assessment for organised team sports.
Croquet	On cricket outfield, please book in advance with Head Groundsman sw355@cam.ac.uk
Hard Courts	Please follow covid guidelines, risk assessment for organised team sports.
Swimming Pool	Opening when filled and tested, hopefully late May. Capacity TBC.

Organised outdoor sport must have a risk assessment signed off by Junior Bursar. Bring and sanitise your own equipment, maintain 2m social distance from anyone you don't live with, arrive ready to play (no changing rooms open yet).

SOCIALISING AND VISITORS GIRTON COLLEGE

17 May 2021 onwards

General indoor areas

- ✓ External visitors permitted, must be accompanied and signed in at the Lodge.
- ✓ 1 accompanied guest per person in Hub and Cafeteria
- ✓ Rule of max 6 at indoor tables
- ✓ Max 10 at outdoor tables in Ash Court

- ✗ No visitors allowed in Library & Study areas
- ✗ No visitors allowed in indoor sports facilities

Households

- ✓ 1 visitor at a time in households notified on the kitchen door register. If not a member of College, must also be signed in and out at the Lodge.
- ✓ Household Visitors must keep to the host's room, wear a face covering when outside the host's room and avoid using shared household spaces.

- ✗ No household parties in exam period without the Senior Tutor's prior permission
- ✗ No visiting a household without invitation & sign in

Outdoors on College Premises

- ✓ Gatherings of up to 10 permitted (away from residential areas to avoid disturbance to those doing exams)
- ✓ Accompanied guests can use outdoor sports facilities

- ✗ No gatherings larger than 10 without the Senior Tutor's prior permission
